Use this funeral wishlist as a template as you plan out your wishes for when you pass. Be sure to sign and date this document, store it in a safe place, and let a friend or family member know where it's located so they can access it when appropriate.

Do I want to be buried or cremated, or have my body donated to science?

Do I want a non-traditional burial?

e.g. Burial at sea, eco-burial

Do I have a preferred burial plot?

If cremated, where do I want my ashes spread, and by whom?

Do I have a preferred funeral home/director?

Include address, contact details and plot number, if applicable.

Do I have funeral insurance?

If so, where are the documents kept?

What are my requests for personalising my funeral?

Who do I want to give the eulogy at my funeral service?

What songs do I want played during the service?

What prayers or readings do I want included during the service?

And who will recite them?

If there will be a casket, who would I like to act as pallbearers?

Do I want the service to be religious or secular?

Include additional details.

Do I want a formal or casual service?

If not at a funeral home, where would I like the service to be held?

e.g. My church, retirement village, family home, graveside

Do I want my casket to be closed, open, or have no coffin present?

Do I want to be dressed in specific clothes?

Do I want any favourite possessions buried / cremated with me?

I've included some eulogy notes to assist with the eulogy speech.

(e.g. Milestone moments, names of important people, beliefs and philosophy, people I want to thank most).
